AY2022-2023 Fulbright Egyptian Student Program Master's Degree

Program Goal

Provides fully-funded master's degree grants for university graduates to study in the U.S. for a maximum of two years.

All Fields are Eligible.

Eligibility Criteria

· Egyptian citizenship.

- Currently residing in Egypt; applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Bachelor's degree. Minimum of "Good" for applicants in the humanities and social sciences. Minimum of "Very Good" for applicants in the sciences.

Proof of English Language proficiency.

- Applicants have to successfully complete all the steps of the application, assessment, and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).
- U.S. citizens and green card holders and applicants are not eligible to apply.

- Students applying in medicine, veterinary medicine, nursing, psychological counselling and dentistry fields should be aware that their programs cannot include clinical studies.
- Preference will be given to applicants without prior significant experience in the U.S. and/or overseas.

AY2022-2023 Fulbright Egyptian Student Program Visiting Student Researcher

Program Goal

Provides fully funded grants for students registered in Ph.D. programs at universities in Egypt to collect data and/or conduct research for six to nine months in the U.S.

All Fields are Eligible.

Eligibility Criteria

- · Egyptian citizenship.
- Currently residing in Egypt; applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- · Master's degree. Strong academic record.
- Applicants must be registered in doctoral degree program at a university in Egypt.
- Applicants have to successfully complete all the steps of the application, assessment, and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).
- U.S. citizens and green card holders and applicants are not eligible to apply.

Program Goal

Provides opportunities for Egyptian post-doctoral faculty members in all fields to conduct research at U.S. institutions for 3 to 9 months.

All Fields are Eligible.

Eligibility Criteria

- Egyptian citizenship
- Currently residing in Egypt; applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Full-time Academic faculty member of an Egyptian university or research institute/center.
- Ph.D. is required.
- Excellent command of English.
- Applicants have to successfully complete all the steps of the application, assessment, and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin). U.S. citizens and green card holders are not eligible to apply.

Notes:

- Scholars applying in medicine, veterinary medicine, nursing, psychological counseling and dentistry fields should be aware that their research cannot include clinical studies.
- Preference will be given to applicants without recent prior significant experience in the U.S. and/or overseas.

- Limited prior experience in the U.S.
- Qualified women are encouraged to apply.
- Applicants have to successfully complete all the steps of the assessment and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- **Note**: Academics with no administrative or management responsibilities, or who don't have professional experience within their field of specialization, are **ineligible** (except in the field of Substance Abuse Education, Prevention, and Treatment).
