- An adjective modifies a noun or pronoun.
- Examples:

Adjectives modifying nouns

• The wealthy farmer surveyed his fertile fields.

Wealthy is an adjective modifying the <u>noun</u> farmer.

Fertile is an adjective modifying the noun fields.

Adjectives modifying pronouns

• That model is a popular one, but those others are better.

That is an adjective modifying the noun model, and popular is an adjective modifying the <u>pronoun</u> one. Those is an adjective modifying the <u>pronoun</u> others. Better is an adjective modifying the <u>pronoun</u> others.
